ACADEMIC YEAR

GRADING AND WEIGHTING SCALES

Advanced Placement and dual enrollment courses are weighted with a 1.0 multiplier.

Honors courses are weighted with a 0.5 multiplier.



DUAL ENROLLMENT

IMG Academy partners with Barry University to offer students a diverse dual enrollment program. Upon completion, students earn both high school credits and college credits from Barry University. Courses are taught on campus by IMG Academy faculty credentialed by Barry University.

COLLEGE PLANNING AND PLACEMENT DEPARTMENT

IMG Academy empowers student-athletes to win their future, preparing them for college and for life. Dedicated staff in our College Planning and Placement Department educates and mentors student-athletes and their family about the college application process, rigorous course selection, college exam preparation, and NCAA compliance requirements, allowing them to seamlessly find the right university that suits their goals.

IMG Academy is unmatched in placing student-athletes on college rosters and have a track record for high academic outcomes with 25 students from the class of 2025 matriculating to top 25 US News colleges, including several lvy League commits. SEAL OF BILITERACY

Student-athletes who show a proficiency in two or more languages by the time of graduation may be awarded the Seal of Biliteracy. The seal formally signifies the accomplishment of bilingual student-athletes and is a powerful tool across college and career applications and scholarships.

ACADEMIC SUPPORT

TUTORING

IMG Academy offers a variety of tutoring opportunities, including assistance during both school sessions as well as evening tutoring options. Fee-based private tutoring sessions are also available.
